INTRODUCTION

Dear Applicant,

Thank you for downloading the YIP19 2026-2027 Application Form.

As YIP encourages individual initiative, the process or the outcome of the program can not be predetermined. It is as Picasso expresses in the above poem: a risk, a venture...only to be taken on by those who wish to become secure in insecurity. YIP aims to host a place for the deep exploration of our purpose in life, coupled with exploration of the urgent needs of the world. We hope that a match can be found that meets both the individual's longing and purpose, as well as a need in today's society and world. A space for initiative and learning, where you can bring your ideas to life!

The process and the outcomes will be highly individual, and largely dependent on the attitude and engagement of those taking part in the program. This Application Process is therefore mainly meant to help you to decide if YIP is the right next step in your journey, whilst also enabling the organizing team to get to know a bit about you, your ideas and inspirations.

How do we decide your acceptance? We are looking for enthusiastic self-motivated young people who have a deep interest in working towards a more just and regenerative future. People who are willing to ask and hold big questions relating to their individual and our collective state of being; open to look reality in the face both from within and out into the world and willing to be part of the change that might be required to improve what you find there. You need to be willing to consciously navigate the joys and challenges of community life and to take part in sculpting your learning. We are interested in your initiative, the ideas and inspirations behind your actions and your ability to be reflective about yourself and these ideas with an open attitude.

Before continuing the application process, please ensure that you have read the terms and conditions included in the initial application form, they will inform you about the practicalities of applying for YIP and make your application process easier.



STEP ONE: WHO ARE YOU?

This part of the application is for us to get to know you and hear why you would like to participate in YIP. For this section, please submit a 1-page Biography, 1-2 page CV and maximum 1-page document for each of the following: the Call, the Landscape and the Horizon. We invite you to give individual responses to each of the bulleted tasks. So STEP ONE should result in no more than 6 pages.

Biography (max. 1 A4): My Life

• Please write a short outline of your biography and include where you were born, how you grew up and the environments, relationships and events that have shaped who you are today.

Formal CV (max. 2 A4): My Education - Please list:

- High School
- University and/or College
- Additional Courses/Diploma
- · Work experience/voluntary engagements

The Call (max. 1 A4): My Impulse

- What do you see as some of the major global challenges we face as humanity today?
- Which of these global challenges do you feel called to work with and why?
- What drives you to participate in a program like YIP?
- What specific areas of YIP interest you most and why?



The Landscape (max. 1 A4): My Influence

- Describe a time when you have shown and/or taken initiative.
- Name one aspect of yourself that you consider a quality that you are able to offer to yourself and those around you and an area you struggle with and would like to develop. Describe how these have influenced your life.

The Horizon (max. 1 A4): My Intention

- In the future you wish to see, what ideals and realities are alive in the world?
- In this future, how do you hope to be living your life and where do you see your engagement in the world you describe? How do you see YIP contributing to this?

STEP TWO: MY QUESTION

All initiatives begin with a question. This step asks you to creatively express a burning question you carry right now that inspires you to step into initiative that is of service to the world.

Activate your creativity inspired by the question below:

What is a question that motivates me to take initiative towards a positive change in myself and/or the world?

Consider: where does your question come from? Who is it for? What are the key elements? How would you begin to address it? We look forward to seeing, hearing, and experiencing your question through song, film, poetry, theatre, movement, painting, sculpture etc. Please do not make it longer than 5 minutes.



STEP THREE: REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS

YIP requires two reference letters which should be sent to apply@yip.se by your referees. Please ensure that both references are from people who know you well from an education/work/mentor position, who can comment objectively on your character, abilities, capacities and/or past experiences. We cannot accept references from family members or close friends. Please print the <u>reference letter template</u> and give it to your referee to complete and either email or post to us. *Please note that your application will only be completed and processed once we have received both references.

• Health Report - CLICK HERE FOR THE HEALTH REPORT FORM

The provided medical report must be completed, signed and stamped by a qualified medical doctor. If you require a special diet, or have any serious allergies please include details of this on your health report. If you have any current or previous medical, mental or physical conditions that may affect your stay at or participation in YIP, we ask that this be clearly stated on the report.

Certificate of Proficiency in English - CLICK HERE FOR THE ENGLISH CERTIFICATE FORM

If English is not your native language, you will need to provide a certificate of proficiency in English. YIP is an intensive full-day course taught in English, with challenging content and in-depth theory based discussions. For your admission it is required that you understand, speak, read and write in English at least at an intermediate level.

* PLEASE NOTE: This is not a 'formality', but an important check for YOU. Experience has shown that people struggle in YIP if they do not understand and speak English well enough. In YIP, reading and writing English is NOT as important as understanding and speaking it. Please listen to the lecture below to see if you understand all that is said. Portrait Photograph

YIP requires a portrait photograph showing only your head (a passport photo or similar) with your application.



STEP FOUR: PAY YOUR APPLICATION FEE
